All Kids Deserve A Strong Start.

By age 5, a child’s brain is already nearly completely developed. During these early years of brain development, it is critical to invest in kids’ futures by providing early learning opportunities.

The Problem.

According to the Annie E. Casey Foundation, more than half of Iowa’s 3- and 4-year-olds were not enrolled in a pre-K program in 2014. In the same year, Iowa ranked 32nd in the nation in state-spending on preschool. Therefore, thousands of Iowa children do not arrive at kindergarten with opportunities equal to those of their peers. Without access to high-quality early learning programs, children fall behind. Many never catch up.

The Solution.

Save the Children Action Network (SCAN) is working with early learning coalition leaders in Iowa to call on elected officials to prioritize a child’s early years and give all kids a bright future. We support efforts to advance early childhood policies that improve and expand high-quality early learning programs in Iowa.
